Ask your hotel/host if they can provide a crib or bring your own travel crib/bassinet Many hotels have cribs available on request for free or to rent, but availability is not guaranteed. Be sure to ask when you reserve your room.				
Block off stairs, open fireplaces and other off-limits areas that don't have doors Figure 1: Bring a baby gate or block with heavy furniture.				
Cover exposed electrical outlets on walls and power strips Use painter's tape or band aids.				
Cushion sharp corners on baseboards, tables and other furniture Use pillows/blankets to cover sharp baseboards. For tables, you can DIY baby bumpers using cut-up pool noodles and tape.				
☐ Hide TV remotes and other battery-powered items from Baby				
Look out for slippery floors Wipe down bathroom floors after showers/bath time so Baby doesn't slip. If Baby wears socks, remove them before letting them walk on floors without carpeting.				
Pack a baby bath mat and/or baby bath seat if you plan to bathe Baby				
Protect hard-to-clean floors from Baby's messes Fig. Bring an old sheet or disposable tablecloth to cover carpeted areas where Baby will be playing or eating so you don't have to worry about stains.				
Remove cleaning products and other chemicals from Baby's reach				
☐ Scan for and put away any potential choking hazards				
Secure low cabinets and drawers Use painter's tape or rubber bands/hair ties.				
Tape up/bind loose cords from electronics or blinds Use painter's tape or twist ties.				
☐ Unplug appliances when not in use and remove cords from Baby's reach
